An estimated **b** million abortions occur annually as of 2015-2019

SSA exhibits a high pregnancy rate: **218 per 1,000**. It displays the highest unintended pregnancy rate of any world region despite having the lowest proportion unintended

In 2019, among the region's

women of reproductive age (15-49),

92% lived in countries with highly or moderately restrictive abortion laws



8 out of 39 SSA countries

that ratified the **Maputo Protocol** reformed their laws to meet its minimum legal criteria since 2003

Poor women in rural areas risk the most by having an unsafe abortion

of abortions among poor rural women result in complications needing treatment compared to 44% of all women



Half of those with complications do not receive needed care

Improving provision of contraceptives and expanding access to safe abortion care and postabortion care services can save lives
